Neighborhood Resident Leader Scholarships Available!

In an effort to promote leadership and participation in your Davenport neighborhood a limited number of reimbursement scholarships are available to neighborhood leaders. Applicants must reside in a Recognized Neighborhood within the City of Davenport.

How it Works: Complete the 40 hrs. of coursework for a Neighborhood Resident Leadership Certificate within a 2 year period and all of the course fees for that coursework will be reimbursed.

BONUS: A limited number of individuals that have completed the certificate program may also be eligible for assistance to attend a national Neighborhoods, USA conference to learn about best practices that they can bring back to their neighborhood in Davenport!
